
## GRAPHOLOGY AND SCIENCE VALIDATION WITH 150 DOCTORAL THESES



Graphology, like projective techniques with which it has much in common, is validated above all by correlation. A total of 150 theses are exhibited in this revisory work, many of which deal with interdisciplinary material where particularities and characteristics are correlated with personality elements or factors, framed within a doctoral thesis, which is a work of scientific research and thus follows all the required guarantees with regards methodology. The result is a homologous body of work which produces meta-analysis guidelines that confirm the validity of each of the research projects, and confers overall validation upon the whole graphological system.

Authors: Mariluz Puente and Francisco Viñals direct several academic and professional

institutions connected with graphological sciences. They are directors of the European Masters in Forensic Science, as well as the European Masters in Graphology, and postgraduate courses in judicial expertise in handwriting analysis and the psychological analysis of handwriting at the Autonomous University of Barcelona. At the same university, they also teach applied scientific criminal investigation techniques and document security technology, which form part of the university degree programmes in Integral Security, Criminology and Private Investigation, and Prevention of Risks in the Workplace. As well as their



doctorate studies, the authors have extensive training and experience in forensic sciences and scientific police work, including experience in criminal intelligence, and also teach civil and military intelligence. Thanks to their academic activities and their contributions as graphoanalysts and official specialists, they have received decorations, awards, honorary distinctions and numerous mentions from the Spanish State and several public and private institutions. In 2010 they were selected as prominent Catalan personalities and included in the 20<sup>th</sup> volume of the *Historia contemporánea de Cataluña*.
